PVC Solvent Cement

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Ensure pipe has been cut square and ends chamfered.
2. Ensure bonding surfaces are clean.
3. Stir the product thoroughly before use.
4. Do not use:
 - If gelling is observed
 - Do not blend with other chemicals.
5. Ensure sufficient solvent cement is applied to bonding surfaces.
6. Immediately insert the pipe into pipe fitting. Ensure that pipe is fully inserted, apply quarter turn and hold in position for 30 sec.
7. Remove any excess solvent cement immediately.
8. Allow setting time of 15 minutes before handling.
9. Ensure proper ventilation in the work area.
10. Curing time before use:
 - Pipes up to 2": 24 hours
 - Pipes up to 6": 48 hours

Note: Longer curing times may be needed in damp or cold conditions.
